### ESHER AND OXSHOTT COMMONS

- LOCATION** *Saturday* – parking at Oxshott Village Sports Club, Steels Lane, Oxshott, KT22 0RF.  
*Sunday* – parking at the Fairmile Inn, Portsmouth Rd, Cobham, KT11 1BW.
- TERRAIN** 1:10,000 map fully revised for the events. Mixed deciduous forest and open heath, with a good path network. Some areas of intricate vegetation, other areas of intricate contour detail.
- COURSES** *Saturday* – full range of M/W 16-75 age classes, plus a Novice course. You are free to enter any age class you like (e.g. M21's who want a shorter course could enter M55), but you will only be eligible for a prize if you satisfy the age class criteria of the course you have entered.  
*Sunday* – full range of colour-coded courses: White, Yellow, Orange, Short Green, Green, Short Blue, Blue, Short Brown, Brown (no Black course). Free String Course.
- STARTS** *Saturday* – 17:00 to 18:30. Exact start times will be allocated in advance.  
*Sunday* – 10:30 to 12:30. Start times will be allocated in 30-minute blocks.
- Start times/blocks will be published online at Fabian4 (link below) in the last week of November.
- TROPHIES** *Saturday* – Southern Night Championship trophies presented to all eligible class winners.  
*Sunday* – The OK Nuts Trophy is in memory of Mike Wells Cole, former British Champion and a member of Nutfielders OK, who died in 1976; this will be awarded to the winner of the Brown course. The Heather Monro Trophy will be awarded to the first woman on the Short Brown course and the Margaret Loveless Trophy for best Junior performance on any course. Additionally, OK Nuts coasters will be awarded for the top 3 on each course based on the range of age classes in the table published on the SLOW website (see link below) and in the final details.

Closing date for online pre-entries is Sunday 25th November, but EOD available (while maps last).
- FEES** *Online advance entries:* Senior – £11 per race (but £2 discount for British Orienteering members) Junior (M/W20-), full time students, all on Orange/Yellow/White/Novice course – £4 (no discount).  
*Entry on the day (subject to map availability):* Senior £13 per event (but £2 discount for B.O. members). Junior, full time students, all on Orange/Yellow/White/novice course – £5 (no discount).  
*Sport Ident card hire:* Seniors – £1 per event, Juniors/Students – no charge.
- Further discount* of £2 seniors/£1 others available online if pre-entering both events together.
- FACILITIES** *Saturday* – indoor facilities (including toilets) but no food or drink available.  
*Sunday* – the Fairmile is a pub restaurant serving food and drink from 11:30am. They have kindly allowed us to park in their grounds so please support them. Toilets available. Ultrasport attending.
