Organiser's Report

One week before the event, the advice published to orienteering clubs by the British Orienteering Federation (BOF) seemed to imply that all orienteering should be cancelled because of the Foot and Mouth disease epidemic. As a result, organisation and planning slowed down a bit over the critical weekend before the event. I was therefore surprised when I called BOF 6 days before the event to find that they were fully supportive of us continuing, provided the Wimbledon Common Conservators and Richmond Park agreed. Both of these bodies were fully supportive of the event and we therefore decided to continue. This surprise decision (to me, at least) left the planner and controller short of time and I was impressed by the way that the courses were completed on time and grateful to Mike Elliot for helping out as Assistant Controller.

One of my main concerns was that, being the only orienteering event in the UK that weekend, we would be overwhelmed by orienteers and have insufficient helpers or car park space. As it turned out, we attracted about the average number of entries for Wimbledon Common events.

I would like to thank everyone who turned up for their good-humoured patience with the 15 minutes delay to the start times and for the many complimentary comments I received about Mike's courses.

I would also like to thank all the SLOW helpers for their help on the day. Special thanks are due to Andrew and Caroline McMillan and their family who organised the string course. The week before, I had incorrectly advised them that the event would probably be cancelled. As a result they planned the course and drew and printed the map on Saturday afternoon, the day before the event. It was therefore very pleasing that over 40 children ran the course.

Finally, our thanks are due to the Wimbledon Common Conservators for permission to use the Common and to Kingston University for the use of the car park.

Planner's Report

Having been one of the main voices within SLOW in favour of going ahead with the event, I was mildly surprised to win the discussion and am relieved that the event's success has shown it to be the correct decision. I am very grateful to SLOW's committee for deciding to go ahead, and also, particularly, to the Wimbledon Common ranger, Jim Reader, for his friendly support and for not succumbing to the national hysteria.

I rate Wimbledon Common as one of the most enjoyable areas I have planned on. Though no experienced orienteer should get lost for very long on it, the intricate path network and varied vegetation of the western side require concentration and enable plenty of choices to be set. The contrast between that and the eyeballs out running required on the eastern side make, in my view, for a good all round test of running speed and navigation.

The most pleasing aspect was that no juniors retired. My main concern with the junior courses had been to try to make them as interesting as possible. I was conscious that this resulted in the courses, particularly yellow, although within guidelines being a bit more challenging than usual. Hopefully the fact that everyone got round, despite some longish times, means that it was a fair challenge.

The uncertainty about the event did at least give me an excuse for my usual tendency to leave things until the last minute. Thanks to Simon Ling for his constructive suggestions as controller, and for being so relaxed about my numerous late changes to the courses. The confusion at registration and delay to the starts were my fault, as I left sorting out controls and punch units until the morning and completely underestimated how long it would take. As a result controls were put out and checked very late, and I made things worse by leaving the control descriptions locked in my boot until 9.40 a.m. while I was in the forest. I received a couple of increasingly frantic mobile calls, but didn't realise until later that everyone coming to the event had arrived and was queueing at registration. I hope the delay did not detract from anyone's enjoyment.

OK Nuts 2000 / Foot and Mouth Disease

This event is rescheduled for May 13th 2001 from Dec 10th 2000. The event area, Winterfold, is adjacent to farm land and the car park normally has sheep on it. There are also deer living in the woods. We currently have entries from all over England, including infected areas. This makes the event extremely vulnerable in the current crisis, with reported cases still occurring daily. The BOF suggested guideline is for events to allow a six week clear period from the last reported outbreak before proceeding.

Regardless of any time scale, our landowners may withdraw permission anyway.

This means that SLOW will make a final decision by the end of March, but at this stage it does not look too hopefull that the event will go ahead. We will write to all currently entered competitors if this occurs using the envelopes provided. We have frozen any new entries and are not issuing a new flyer.

Please note that not all previously entered competitors have confirmed whether they wish to keep their entries. Despite the uncertainty over the new date I would be grateful if competitors who have not yet replied would do so as soon as possible.
