	<b>What the Competitor Needs to Know</b>	<b>What the Organiser &amp; Planner Need to Know</b>
<b>Battery Test Box</b>	<b>Dib and wait for beep</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1 beep: battery OK</li> <li>5 beeps: battery weak, OK for 3-4 events</li> <li>No beep: battery flat - Either seek replacement at SIAC hire or use in dibber mode for this event</li> <li>Does NOT activate Contactless mode</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If there is a Remote Start then this needs to be at the Arena Exit</li> <li>Otherwise in Pre-Start area</li> <li>Not required at small events <sup>3</sup></li> </ul>
<b>Clear Box</b>	<b>Dib and wait for box to beep</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Clears the card memory</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Clear &amp; synchronise before event <sup>4</sup></b></li> <li>Locate in Pre-Start Area</li> </ul>
<b>Check Box</b>	<b>Dib and wait for beep</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Checks card is cleared</li> <li>Activates SIAC Contactless mode - <a href="#">SIAC will flash red &amp; beep 3 times</a></li> <li>(card flashes faint green every 10 secs)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Clear &amp; synchronise before event <sup>4</sup></b></li> <li>Locate in Pre-Start Area</li> <li>Need to send this box to Results team as soon as the Start closes to help check who is out on the course</li> </ul>
<b>SIAC Test Box</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Swipe within 50 cm of box</li> <li>SIAC will flash red &amp; beep 3 times to confirm SIAC is in Contactless mode.</li> <li>Box will not flash or beep</li> <li>If no beep, then SIAC is not in Contactless mode - dib again at the Check Box</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Clear &amp; synchronise before event. <sup>4</sup></b></li> <li>Must be after <b>Check Box</b> – and after next minute line to ensure SIAC stops beeping before the check</li> <li>Consider taping over hole in the unit to avoid competitors with a non SIAC Card trying (pointlessly) to dib</li> <li>Not required at small events<sup>3</sup></li> <li><b>Use default of 12 hours ON. After the event switch off with the Purple OFF key <sup>6</sup></b></li> </ul>
<b>Start Box</b>	<b>Dib and wait for beep</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Records start times in SIAC</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Clear &amp; synchronise before event. <sup>4</sup></b></li> <li>For any but the smallest events It is a good idea to have two Start units for redundancy</li> <li>Convention is for this to be dibbing only, which avoids confusion and...</li> <li>Records everyone who has started</li> <li>Need to send this box to Results team as soon as the Start closes to crosscheck who is out on the course</li> <li><b>Could be fitted with Radio Unit <sup>1</sup></b></li> </ul>
<b>Control Boxes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Swipe within 50 cm of box</li> <li>SIAC will flash red &amp; beep 3 times <sup>2</sup></li> <li>Control unit will <u>not</u> flash or beep</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Clear &amp; synchronise before event <sup>4</sup></b></li> <li>Make sure that either the hanger or checker dibs each one to activate it so that the first competitor through doesn't have to do so by dibbing</li> <li><b>Could be fitted with Radio Unit<sup>1</sup></b></li> <li><b>Use default of 12 hours ON when in Contactless Mode. After the event switch off with the Purple OFF key <sup>6</sup></b></li> </ul>
<b>Finish Box</b> Either Dibbing Only or Contactless enabled	<b>If Dibbing Only</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Dib and wait for box to beep</li> <li>Deactivates SIAC Contactless mode</li> </ul> <b>If Contactless</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Swipe within 50 cm of box</li> <li>SIAC will flash red &amp; beep 3 times <sup>2</sup></li> <li>Deactivates SIAC Contactless mode <sup>5</sup></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Clear &amp; synchronise before event <sup>4</sup></b></li> <li>For any but the smallest events It is a good idea to have two Finish boxes for redundancy</li> <li>Competitors must be informed before the event whether the Finish is Contactless, punching or run through (<i>BOF Rule A 7.5.8</i>)</li> <li>When Contactless punching is enabled at a Level A event the Finish box <u>must</u> allow Contactless punching (<i>BOF Rule A 7.5.6</i>)</li> <li><b>Could be fitted with Radio Unit <sup>1</sup></b></li> <li><b>Use default of 12 hours ON when in Contactless Mode. After the event switch off with the Purple OFF key <sup>6</sup></b></li> </ul>
<b>Safety Check Box</b> (only used if Remote Contactless Finish)	<b>Dib and wait for beep</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Gives consolidated record of all finishers</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Clear &amp; synchronise before event <sup>4</sup></b></li> <li>Needs to be &gt;10 m from Finish Box to give time for SIAC to stop beeping and hence register here</li> </ul>
<b>Download Box</b>	<b>Dib and wait for beep</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Downloads time into the Results System</li> <li>Deactivates SIAC Contactless mode <sup>5</sup> if you have missed the Finish</li> </ul>	

- 1 This would give the Results team real time updates on competitor status. More information in the follow up article in the next issue
- 2 If there are other competitors punching at the same time, it may be useful to hold the SIAC near to your ear to hear it beep
- 3 This would be overkill at a Level D event!

- 5 Reduces drain on the SIAC battery
- 6 Reduces drain on unit battery. Otherwise, will not switch off for 12 hours
