### Notes

Sarah Brown is the start official in “Start Orienteering”, presented by Graham Gristwood, the first leg of the GB men's relay team that won gold in 2008. “Using the Compass” was filmed by Mårten Boström of Finland, who was Sprint Gold Medallist in 2013. Kris Jones was #17 in the Men's Sprint rankings on 1/1/2018 - the IOF database allows historic searches, or you could check the articles tagged “Rankings” at [www.ontheredline.org.uk](http://www.ontheredline.org.uk). The videos were all edited by Katherine Bett of Southern Navigators - and Alice Leake ran the final leg for their team that won silver at Summer House Knott in May 2017. On 1<sup>st</sup> June 2013 Chris Smithard came fourth in that year's Nordic Tour Sprint Race in Oslo, which was World Cup Race 4. This is in Chris's athlete entry on the BOF site.
