

Location & Assembly

WIMBLEDON COMMON. Thames Hare and Hounds Clubhouse at Richardson Evans Memorial Playing Fields. SW15 3PQ. Grid Ref TQ214722. The clubhouse entrance is at the SW end of the building.

Travel & Parking

Cycle racks are available immediately outside the entrance of the clubhouse. (Note that due to the deer cull in neighbouring Richmond Park, you will not be able to cycle through the park after 8pm).

Bus routes 85, 265, K3 pass by the clubhouse, Closest stops "Roehampton Vale Campus" – Westbound, or "Roehampton Vale Asda" – Eastbound. See <u>tfl website</u> for further details.

Parking is available at the playing fields, the entrance is only accessible travelling Westbound, please share vehicles where possible. In the unlikely event that parking is full, free on-street parking can be found to the SW (Vale Crescent / Robin Hood Way) or NE (Friars Avenue / Stroud Crescent).

To be eligible for the championship, SEOA members must enter the applicable course for their age as below. However, you may choose to enter a different course, but will not be able to win a prize.

Map

1:10,000 with 5m contours. All maps A4 size and on waterproof paper with course details and control descriptions on the front.

Terrain

All courses use the western and central parts of the Common and are predominantly in forest. Wimbledon Common has substantial undergrowth and this is not the best time of year in that respect, but the courses will take you to the nicer, runnable areas. In some areas the undergrowth may be more extensive than mapped.

All courses use the golf course area. **Please do not go on the golf greens.** These are not marked on the map but are easy to see and easy to go around.

All courses will cross the river which flows past the clubhouse where assembly is (to the west of the map); please use the bridges which are clearly shown on the map.

You may come across a large area taped off with red and white tape. Holly is being cleared and burnt in this area. You are not expected to need to, but you may enter it if you wish. You may also find smoking embers; do not be alarmed but take care.

Control Descriptions

Control descriptions will be available in the start lanes and printed on the maps. IOF Pictorial descriptions only.

Start, Start Times, Controls & Course Closing Time

The Start is approximately 100m from the clubhouse.

Starts - 17:30 to 18:30.

Start times can be viewed at SiEntries

It will be a punching Start but all controls, including the finish, will be contactless for those who have a contactless dibber.

The finish is also close to the clubhouse.

Courses Close at 20:30. You must report back to the clubhouse by this time.
